

Schedule:

Gough can tailor your Preventive Maintenance Program to meet your needs. Visits can be quarterly or semi-annually. Visits are typically Monday through Friday during normal working hours.

Services Provided:

Inspection and adjustment of the system will typically include the following:

- ◆ Tipping rack assemblies
- ◆ Main sprocket alignment
- ◆ Main chain tensioners
- ◆ Adjust setting of load unit parts
- ◆ Visual inspection of buckets and components
- ◆ Power transmission components such as drive chain, oil level, drive sprockets, etc.
- ◆ Main chain tracks

Documentation Provided:

At the conclusion of each service visit, Gough Econ will provide a detailed report outlining the items inspected and any corrective action required. Also, the service technician will recommend replacement parts, which will be followed by a quote from customer service.
